



## JCI Barbados Green Roots Project Art Competition

### 2015 Rules and Regulations

The competition is being held under the following themes:

1. Theme for Primary School Participants: “The three R’s – Reduce, Reuse & Recycle”
2. Theme for Secondary School Participants: “The three new R’s – Regeneration, Resurgence & Rejuvenation”

Definitions:

- *Regeneration - re-grow, being born again, given renewed life*
- *Resurgence - a revival*
- *Rejuvenation - making young and youthful again*

The JCI Barbados Green Roots Project invites students from primary and secondary schools across Barbados to submit entries for the Art Competition. The Green Roots Project is the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual initiative seeking to educate young Barbadians about their environment, history and moreover to build an awareness of the need to make Barbados a “green society” thereby meeting one of the national strategic objectives of Barbados.

**Artwork submitted to our competition will be judged based on the following elements of LOCALLY INSPIRED artistic/design expressions:**

**Artwork Criteria:**

1. Drawings (*pieces not exceeding 12 inches x 18 inches*).
2. Paintings (*pieces not exceeding 12 inches x 18 inches*).
3. Collages (*pieces not exceeding 12 inches x 18 inches*).
4. 3-Dimensional Sculptures in any medium.

**Marking Criteria:**

1. Creativity and originality of the depicted theme.
2. Quality of artistic composition and overall incorporation or depiction of recyclable materials based on the theme.
3. Interpretation and the clarity of the theme to the viewer.
4. Overall impression of the art.
  - *What is the visual impact of the artwork in general and as a whole?*
  - *Does the artwork stand on its own as a complete and outstanding work of art?*

## Selection Criteria:

### Reasons for being selected for final judging;

- **1. Good image quality concept.** E.g. Colours are shown to be balanced, are within symmetry and are well proportioned.
- **2. Good artistic expression.** Careful attention to detail and presentation.
- **3. Complete and well written submission materials.** Registration forms are expected to be received complete and clearly written detailing the artists' submissions.

## Submission Criteria:

1. The designated Art teacher for each school must deliver the art piece/s to the location where judging will take place. *(The schools will be notified of this location)*
2. On submission, all pieces must be authenticated by the Art teacher/designated teacher signifying the work was done by the student.
3. Completed registration forms must be submitted by the Art teacher/designated teacher with the name of the school, names of the respective student/s, the name of the piece/s and the contact info of the student/s.

## Art Competition Age Criteria:

### Primary Schools

- 4 – 6
- 7 – 9
- 9+

### Secondary Schools

- 11 – 13
- 14 - 16

- November 20<sup>th</sup> informing schools' representatives of winners.

## Additional Rules

- Entries are limited to one piece per student.
- Collaborative entries are permitted once a student has not already entered an individual piece.
- Students in each age criteria should be the age at the time of submission deadline.
- Art teacher/designated teacher will select the top three pieces from each age group category to be submitted for judging.
- A panel of judges will deliberate on the pieces submitted. The Judges' decision is final.

## Prizes

The top 3 entries in each age group will receive a prize. The school of the first place winner from each age group category will receive a trophy and a cash prize.

## Art Work Exhibition

Winning art work will be displayed and featured at the business/agency of the main sponsor/s of the competition for six (6) months and afterwards will be returned to the schools.
